Operation Carelift isn't just about hand-delivering CarePacks and humanitarian aid, it's about sending people to the former Soviet Union to be living testimonies of the gospel of Jesus Christ. Twice a year *Operation Carelift* takes approximately 200 volunteers on short term mission trips to Belarus, Ukraine, Western Russia and Siberia. The participants are everyday Christians, whether 5 or 85 years old, who have a heart for sharing the good news of Jesus Christ. They become the hands and feet of Jesus to needy children and adults in the orphanages, prisons, hospitals, youth camps and other facilities. Most of these children have been abused, abandoned and forgotten. They want to know if anyone loves and cares about them. By sharing a hug, a smile, and your time, you can be the one to let a hurting child know that he or she is loved by God.

Come join *Operation Carelift* in 2005 and make a difference physically, emotionally, and spiritually in the lives of children and adults across the former Soviet Union. It's a life-changing event in your life as well!

Instructions for giving CarePacks to hurting children

All *CarePacks* must be shipped between September 1 and October 9, 2004. *CarePacks* postmarked after October 9, 2004 will not be delivered on **Operation Carelift 2005 Winter Project**.

1. Use the supply list on the right of this form as a shopping list to purchase the *CarePack* items.
2. Include a picture of yourself and/or your family and a short personal note for each *CarePack* you send. If you are sending multiple *CarePacks*, you may wish to write only one note and make photocopies. Please print very clearly. Your letter and picture will be the most treasured items the children receive. And if you include your address, you may even hear back from the child who receives your *CarePack*.
3. All items must fit and seal in a 1 gallon "zip-lock" bag.
4. Write in the total number of each item packed and place the zip-lock bag(s) in a box for shipping. Use newspaper to help prevent items from shifting during transport. **DO NOT** wrap items.
5. In a separate envelope, include \$5.00 for each *Care-Pack* you are sending. (Cash or check payable to Operation Carelift. Receipts will not be issued. Your canceled check will be your receipt.) These funds will be used to cover shipping costs. We will also add a gospel bead bracelet and translated copies of a children's Bible storybook and **More Than a Carpenter** to each *CarePack*.
6. Ship to the Pennsylvania Warehouse or bring your *CarePacks* with you!
